Sentence Fluency. . . .

- Purple **Figurative Language**
similes, metaphors, personification, figures
of speech, pun, oxymoron, synecdoche

 - Green **One word sentences (not dialogue, not sound)**

 - Brown **All other writing techniques**

 - Orange **Sentences started with Subordinate Conjunctions**
When, As, If, After, Before, So that, While,

- Red **Short sentences with between 2-6 words**

 - Yellow **Medium sentences with between 7-15 words**

 - Blue **Long sentences with 16 or greater words**

You must color code in order from top to bottom; The techniques on the top are the most technical on down. All sentences could be red, yellow, or blue, but it is more important that they are orange, green, brown, or purple than red, yellow, or blue.
